2015-2016 CVP Water Supply Update

Reclamation currently has approximately 3.2 million acre-feet of water in key reservoirs; this represents about 50% of the 15-year average. Shasta Reservoir storage is approximately 1.9 million acre-feet (70% of average). Federal storage in San Luis Reservoir is approximately 50,000 acre-feet (22% of average). Hydrology continues to be well below average with the Northern Sierra 8-Station and the San Joaquin 5-Station indices recording only 75% and 47%, respectively, of average precipitation for the water year ending September 30. Jones Pumping Plant has been exporting water at less than 10% of capacity and has pumped approximately 9,700 acre-feet thus far in August.

Rescheduled Water

The District rescheduled approximately 200,000 acre-feet of water in San Luis Reservoir on March 1, 2015. It is expected the opportunity to continue to store and use this water will not be limited through the 2015-2016 contract year.

2015-2016 Supplemental Water Supply Update

The District received timely Supplemental Water applications for approximately 309,000 acre-feet on 412,000 acres. The District anticipates that it will fulfill only about 90,000 to 105,000 acre-feet of the Supplemental Water requests; however, the majority of supplemental water will not be allocated until the end of the year. The District has allocated 8,000 acre-feet to-date. For the most part, remaining allocations will occur after October 2015. The delivered cost to water users is estimated to be in the range of \$1,300-\$1,350 per acre-foot.

Reclamation continues to manage upstream reservoir releases into the Sacramento River under a plan approved by the State Water Resources Control Board to protect winter-run Chinook salmon. Reclamation will maintain Keswick base releases of 7,250 cfs through August, and target 56F to 58F at Clear Creek. The State Board's goal is to maintain temperature control and conserve cold water resources in Shasta Reservoir. The effect of this lower target of base releases is that less water will be available at the Delta for export.

Implementation of the temperature management plan will delay the conveyance of transfer water purchased by the District until after October 2015. Additionally, Reclamation borrowed water stored in San Luis Reservoir to meet the summertime demands of the Exchange Contractors. However, the District, Reclamation, Sacramento River Settlement Contractors, and San Luis & Delta-Mendota Water Authority will complete all necessary tasks to ensure that all of the District's transfer water is conveyed south-of-Delta this year, that Reclamation returns all borrowed water before the end of the year, and that Reclamation's return of borrowed water does not interrupt the conveyance of transfer water.

Land-Based Charges September Installment
