The Resources Engineer: will plan, organize, assign, direct, control, and supervise special projects within the District's Resources Division including engineering design and technical work, policy analysis, water projects operations, land acquisition, power, drainage, groundwater, water conservation and environmental compliance. This position will serve as a Project Manager and Engineer on various projects related to land acquisition, groundwater, drainage, power resources, water conservations and environmental regulations. The Resources Engineer position will assist in the development of the Division's annual budget, review expenditures to ensure compliance and justify any variances.
