Distribution System Integration Program

Consent to Allow Pumping Groundwater
Into the District's Distribution System

Westlands Water District's Board of Directors has approved a Distribution System Integration Program (Program) which allows a water user (Pumper) with a Conveyance Agreement to pump groundwater into the District's distribution system. The Program requires that the Pumper obtain written consent for such pumping from all other water users on the lateral. The Pumper has had the groundwater analyzed and it meets the water quality requirements of Table 1, of the Procedures for Pumping Groundwater into the District's Distribution System. Copies of the latest water quality analysis are enclosed.

Water User agrees to notify the affected Landowner and/or other lessee or contractor that he has granted permission for Pumper to pump groundwater into the lateral specified in this consent agreement. Water User further agrees to hold the District harmless from any claim for damage to crops, lands, facilities, and equipment because of the quality of water delivered to the Water User. Pumper agrees to discontinue pumping into the designated lateral within 24 hours of receiving notice that permission to pump has been withdrawn or suspended.
