Westlands Water District is Hiring an: **Equipment Mechanic**

Minimum Qualifications

Education and Experience: Possess a United States' high school diploma or General Equivalency Diploma (GED) and five (5) years of experience as a heavy equipment mechanic supplemented by specialized training in maintenance and repair.

Standard Requirement

This position requires regular operation of District vehicles and various heavy-duty equipment in the performance of assigned duties. Incumbents must possess and maintain a valid California Class C Driver's License and a driving record acceptable to the District's automobile insurance.

In addition, the selected candidate must possess a California Class A Driver's License with air brake endorsement and an automotive air conditioning certificate for service and repair, or obtain both within twelve (12) months of appointment. Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) or other similar certifications highly desired.

Position Summary

The vacancy currently exists at the Five Points Shop & Field Office, approximately 45 minutes southwest of Fresno, CA. Normal working hours are Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. with a thirty (30) minute lunch, and summer hours are 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Immediate and future vacancies may be filled from this eligibility list.

Under supervision of the Senior Automotive and Warehouse Coordinator, performs repair, and maintenance on automotive vehicles; construction-type, mobile, earth-moving, and load-lifting equipment; and various heavy-duty, portable, and stationary engines. Equipment Mechanic is a skilled level classification.

Coordinates, organizes, and provides instruction relative to the work of the automotive shop; assists in setting job priorities and selecting repair means and methods. Performs predictive and preventive maintenance, inspections, diagnostics, service, and repair of engines, transmissions, differentials, steering systems, brakes, automotive vehicles, construction-type, mobile, earth-moving, and load-lifting equipment, and heavy-duty portable and stationary engines. Repairs or replaces defective parts and accessories, including the use of acetylene or arc welding equipment; services and repairs air conditioning systems with appropriate refrigerant; and performs tire replacement, repair, and balancing. Maintains and services shop equipment, including stationary fuel pumps, steam cleaners, high-pressure washers, pneumatic air equipment, auto shop hoists, automated fleet and fuel management systems, and waste oil tanks. Performs CHP BIT and monthly safety inspections on trucks and tractor-trailers, completes inspection documentation, and responds to field service calls to repair or transport equipment and vehicles. Assists in the development and implementation of equipment maintenance and repair programs and utilizes computer-based resources, including Mitchell ProDemand, OBD scan tools, and other online resources. Performs other duties as assigned.
